### UPDATED PROPOSED CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS VOTE TODAY:

A special business meeting will be held following this morning's Worship Service for the purpose of voting on the proposed documents.

- Only the Regular Members present in the meeting are eligible to vote.
- No discussion will be held at this meeting, just voting.
- There will be a 10 minute recess following the Worship Service so the Hispanic ministry can make their way to the Worship Center and parents can pick up their children.
- No child care during the meeting since there will not be discussion. Also, this will allow children's workers to be in the meeting. Children will be allowed to sit with their parents who are Regular Members.
- If the proposal passes, copies without highlights and the Draft watermark will be available next Sunday.

**The Motion being presented today:** The Board of Deacons and the Board of Trustees move that the current Constitution and Bylaws of Faith Baptist Church be replaced with the proposed Constitution and Bylaws, effective July 1, 2017.
